The ***Rodney Davies, Joe Dan Johnson, and Gerald Lankes Memorial Scholarships*** are open to all **Central Texas*** students pursuing a concrete-related degree.

Applicants are required to fill out the form on the following pages. The recipients of the scholarships are **REQUIRED** to provide a brief (15-minute) presentation to the Chapter regarding their concrete studies or ACI student chapter activities. The presentation must take place at the Chapter's monthly luncheon on the second Thursday of February or the second Thursday of April the following year (i.e. applying in 2024, recipients will need to present in 2025).

The deadline for application submission is October 31 at 5:00 pm.

Submissions will be accepted between September 1 and October 31 at 5:00pm.
